#### Exploringthe LiberalArts

Exploring the Liberal Arts or "Exploring" is a term used by UNC for students who have not yet decided on or declared a specific major. Typically students choose to be Exploring for one or more of the following reasons. They:

- x are uncertainabout what they want to study.
- x havemanyinterestsand want to exploreseveral options first.
- x declared a major but no longer want to pursueit.
- x were not initially admitted to their preferred major.

Students should take their interests, skills, values, goals, and abilities into consideration when choosing a major. <u>Soa</u> radvisors will work with Exploring students to help them navigate and connect with additional resources on campusto identify goals.

UNCnew or transfer students, who are unsureabout what program of study is best suited to their goals, can choose to be designated as Exploring the Liberal Arts when they enter the University. A clear path for degree completion is of the utmost importance. For this reason, students designated as Exploring the Liberal Arts are required to declare a major by the time they have completed thirty (30) credit hours toward graduation, including transfer credit.
