Changes IURP & URULU

- x Reduce minimum number of required credits from 40 to 31.**
- x Change the name from Liberal Arts Core to the Liberal Arts Curriculum.
- x Add the option of an Advanced Writing Course for students who have already completed the requirements for an Intermediate Writing Course.**
- x Eliminate the requirement of taking courses from two different subcategories in Arts & Humanities.**
- x Eliminate the requirement of taking courses from two different subcategories in Social & Behavioral Sciences (if more than one course is taken in that category).**
- x Eliminate the requirement of taking courses from two different prefixes in Natural & Physical Sciences.**
- x Eliminate the current electives category.
- x Remove exceptions to ENG 122 and MATH requirements for students with high enough SAT/ACT scores **
- x Change the multicultural and international studies requirements as follows
 - o Move United States Multicultural Studies and International Studies from their positions as separate categories into the Liberal Arts Curriculum
 - o Specify a "U.S. Multicultural and International Studies Requirement" that all students must take at least one course designated as U.S. Multicultural Studies and at least one course designated International Studies.
 - o Change the "Arts & Humanities, History and Social and Behavioral Sciences 15 credits" heading to "Arts & Humanities, History, Social & Behavioral Sciences, Multicultural, and International Studies 15 credits".
 - o Provide a list of courses designated as U.S. Multicultural Studies and a list of conignated as International Studies before the Arts & Humanitiestory, and Social & Behavioral Sciencescategories. Mark all courses in those categories as having the [MS] or [IS] designation.
 - o Note: This results in two independent requirements to satisfy the 15 credits from Arts & Humanities History, and Social & Behavioral Sciences) students must complete 6 credits in Arts & Humanities 3 credits in History 3 credits in Social & Behavioral Sciences 3 credits in any of those categories; and (n completing these 15 credits, students must complete at least one course designated [MS] and at least one course designated [IS].

NOTE: These changes will take effect in Fall 2021.

U.S Multicultural and International Studies Requirem ent:

At least one course (3 credits) must carry a Multicultural Studies [MS] designation, and at least one course (3 credits) must carry an International Studies [IS] designation. Courses with these designations are listed below **annal**rked where they appear in the Arts & Humanities, History, and Social & Behavioral Sciences categories.

Courses designated as U.S.Multicultural Studies:

Select one course to be used toward the state mandated minimum 15 credits required in the *Arts & Humanities, History*, and *Social & Behavioral Sciences*categories.

Courses designated as International Studies:

Select one course to be used toward the state mandated minimum 15 credits required in the *Arts & Humanities*, *History*, and *Social & Behavioral Sciences*categories.
